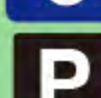
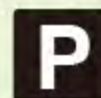

## Miyajidake Shrine

Miyajidake shrine was built around 1700 years ago, it is known as “The god of good luck who overcomes everything”. Miyajidake shrine attracts many visitors throughout the year. It is famous for the largest straw rope in Japan which hangs in front of the main hall, and “Path of light” which can be seen twice a year, on February and October. Many of visitors also come to visit each of the eight temples which called “Oku no Miya Hassha Mairi” to pray for extra luck. Seasonal flowers bloom throughout the year, which is one of the attractions.



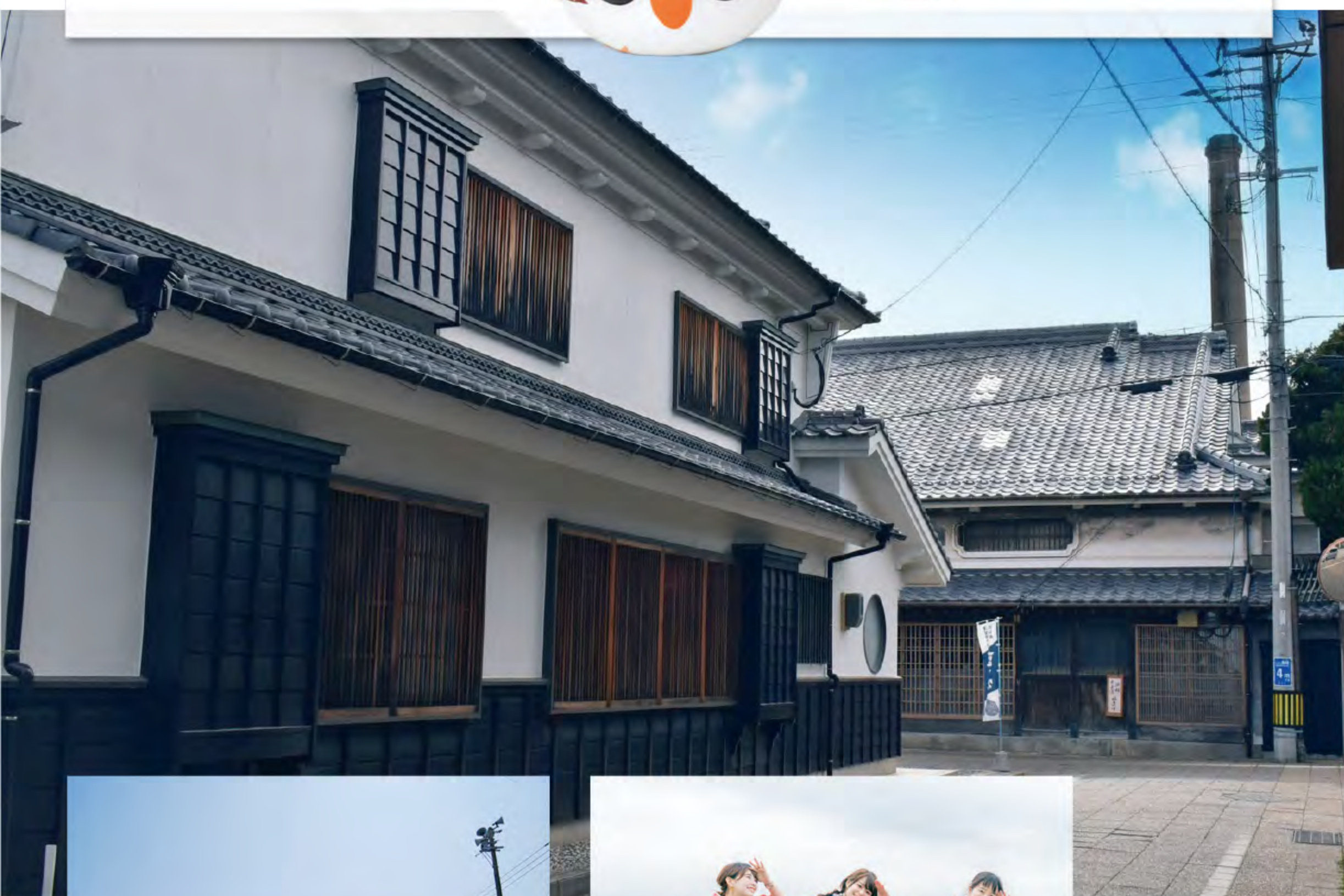
## Beach

There are some luxury beachside cafes and marine sports shops on 3km long shallow and vast beach. “Fukutsu Sea Mirror (Kagami no Umi)” is a popular photo spot, where the beach reflects the sky like a mirror at the low tide.



## Tsuyazaki Sengen

From Edo period to Meiji Period, this place flourished through maritime trade and salt pan. Kimono rental is available on the street, while traditional clay doll craft ‘Tsuyazaki ningyo’ called ‘Momabue’ and ‘Gonta’ are also popular, which looks cute and humorous.
